FALL BIBLE STUDY

Fr. Turner is pleased to present a six-week Bible study on the Book of Ecclesiastes. Autumn, as the season of maturity, is an apt time to ponder the teachings of Ecclesiastes. It's considered part of the Bible's wisdom literature, pointing us to detachment so we can find genuine abundance. Here is a description of the book from a well-known commentary:

Ecclesiastes is one of the most atypical books of the Old Testament, a composition virtually unique both in its genre and in the manner in which it voices opinions seemingly contrary to the mainstream of biblical teaching. In it, a *persona* who seems to identify himself as King Solomon engages in a philosophical thought-experiment about the meaning of life that leads him to the brink of despondency. Despite the darkness of the book, however, believers through the ages have found solace and catharsis in its pages, and spiritual writers have continued to recommend meditation on it as an aid to detachment from the temporal world and its fleeting pleasures.

ADULT CONFIRMATION CLASSES

Adult Confirmation class for the Fall will **begin this week** on Tuesday, September 30, 2025, for adults who are 18 or older who have not received this sacrament and would like to. In addition to being at least 18 years of age, candidates must also have been baptized in the Roman Catholic Church, have received the Sacrament of First Holy Communion, be able to provide sacramental records or other suitable proof of having received those sacraments, and if married, must be in a valid Catholic marriage, or have resolved all questions of sacramental marriage.

Classes will be held on Tuesday evenings, from 7:00-8:30 p.m. at St. Therese Parish Center (555 Middletown Avenue/North Haven). If all requirements are met, this six-week preparation will enable the candidate to receive the sacrament of Confirmation on Tuesday, November 18, 2025, at the Cathedral of St. Joseph in Hartford.




